

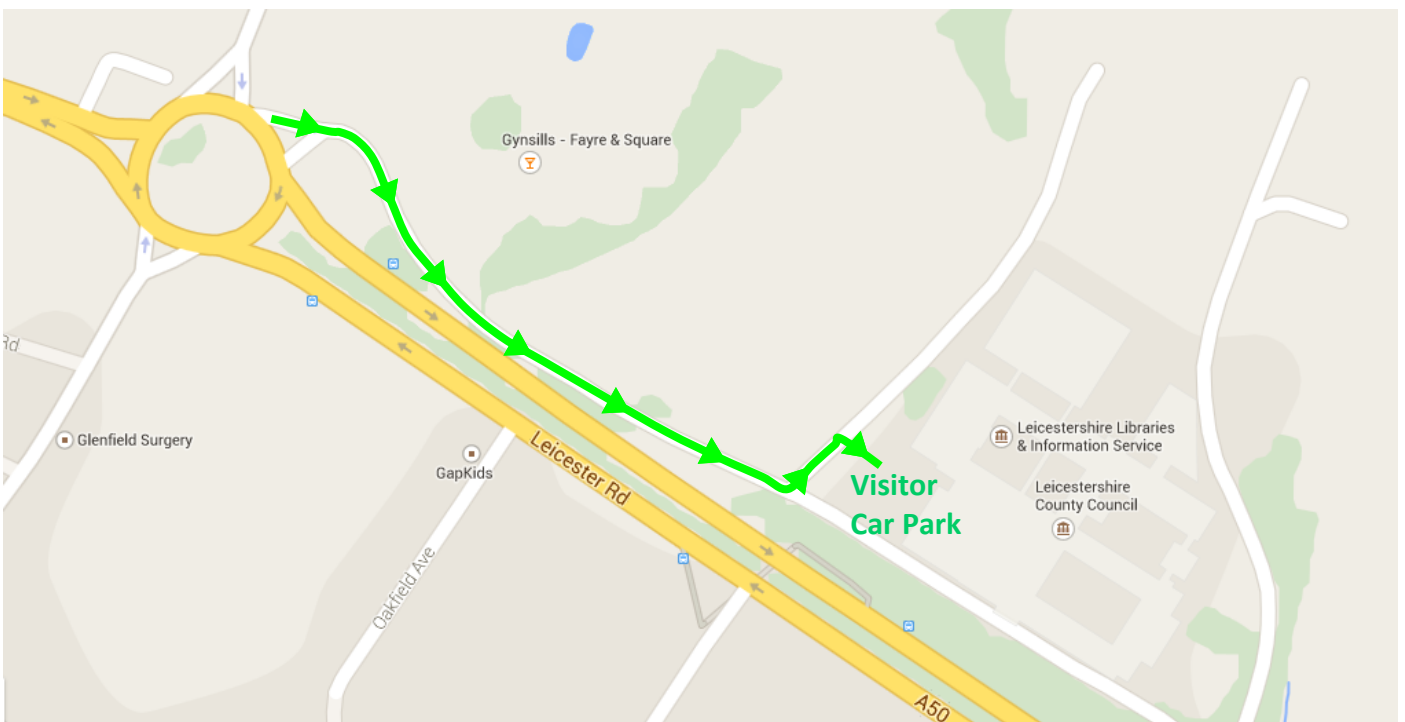
How to get to a 'Find out about adoption' event at County Hall

County Hall is located in Glenfield, next to Glenfield Hospital on the A50 west of Leicester city centre.

It is really easy to get to from any direction, as it is also very close to the A46 and the A563 ring road. It is very well signposted from all the roads in the area. The postcode is **LE3 8RA**

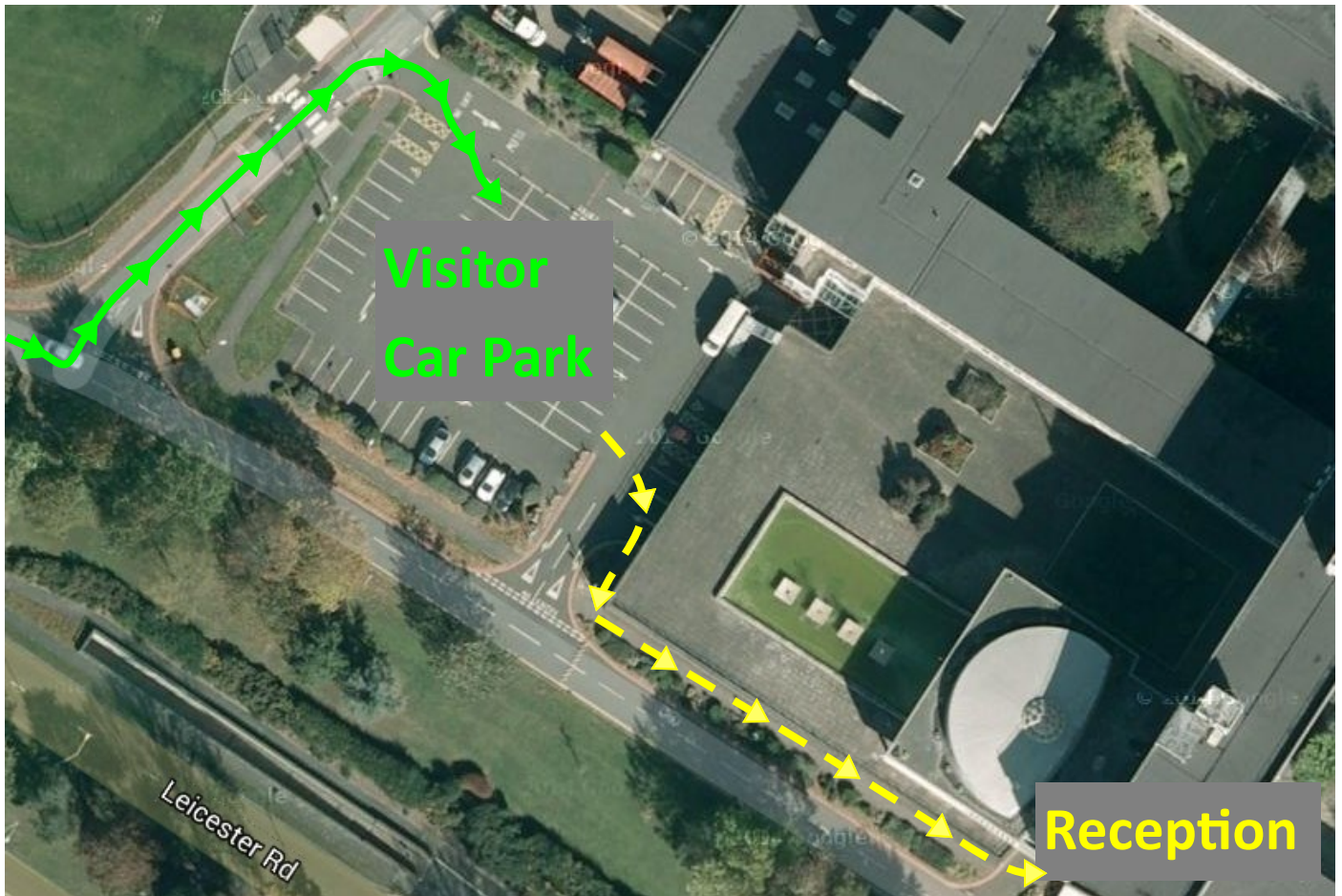


Whichever direction you come from, the way in is from a roundabout on the A50, at the junction with Station Road and Gynsill Lane.



When on the entry road, follow the signs for County Hall, taking the left turn for the car parks. The first right turn is the Visitor Car Park, which is signposted. Parking here is free, and you don't need a pass or ticket.

When you have parked up, walk towards the main building and follow the signs for reception to the right. You will be greeted by one of the team in reception.



The event is very informal, warm and welcoming. The presentation starts at around 6.30pm and lasts roughly an hour. After this you can chat with members of the adoption team, as well as a current adopter.

Please arrive at County Hall for around 6.15pm, which will give you plenty of time to get signed in and settled with a cup of tea or coffee. Children are very welcome to attend too.
